Dear Sir,

As a former member of the Club (ca 2005 - boat "Piculet", Nicholson 27) when living in Gunnislake, I wish to make an enquiry concerning a sailing assistance this summer by an experienced sailor who would be able to find the time and help me to sail my boat from Kent to Devonport. Terms and conditions are subject to agreement.

The reason for my need is that I am not proficient in single-handling enough to be able to navigate the English Channel on my own, especially when I wish to sail my boat day and night, non-stop, until the Sound of Plymouth has been reached, and when my former aid is no longer physically fit to assist.

The departure point : Patmans' Wharf (Post Code: ME2 4UY) moorings, Upnor, River Medway, opposite to Chatham Marina, Kent.

The route planned : Sheerness, N. Foreland, Goodwin, Dungeness Point, Owers of Selsey Bill, St Catherine Point of Wight, The Needles, Portland Bill, Start Point, Plymouth Sound. The full passage plan has already been elaborated and is waiting to be brought into operation.

The destination point : Huggins Bros Ltd Boatyard, Hamoaze, Torpoint, Plymouth

The time span : from the beginning of June till the end of August, 2017

Approx. distance : 290 n. miles

Approx. time taken : 67 hours

I should be immensely grateful if you could find someone who would be willing to take this sailing opportunity and thus help me to bring my craft to Torpoint.
