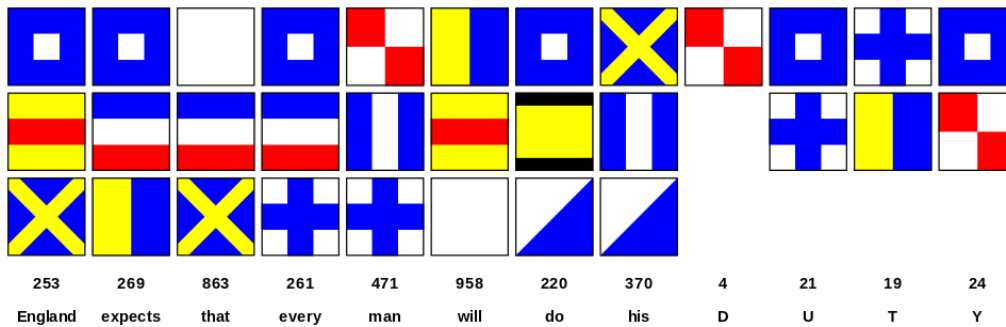




Cargreen Yacht Club: Trafalgar Night Celebrations Wednesday October 21st 2020, 20.15 for 20.30 via Zoom.
