# 2 About this policy

2.1 Our Articles of Association (Article 5 amended 23 July 2005) say that:

Membership of the Club shall be open to all persons irrespective of ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or beliefs; or of age, sex or disability except as a necessary consequence of the requirements of yachting as a particular sport. (Amended 23 July 2005)

- 2.2 This policy extends that requirement to all present and potential members, volunteers, participants and employees of the Club. It applies to participation in all activities of the Club.
- 2.3 Appointments to voluntary or paid positions with the Club will be made solely on the basis of the competences required for the role and an individual's knowledge, skills and experience and willingness to serve.
- 2.3 The Committee reserves the right to amend this Equality Policy from time to time without prior notice. You are advised to check our website (www. cagreenyc.org) or our Club noticeboard regularly for any amendments.

### 3 Implementation of the policy

- 3.1 The Committee has adopted this policy (15 May 2019).
- 3.2 The policy is monitored on an ongoing basis and reviewed on an annual basis, by the Committee.
